Max E Summers Biography

Max is a graduate of the University of Missouri-Columbia and the Graduate School of Banking at the University of Colorado. He spent 15 years as a bank CEO and was with the Small Business & Technology Development Centers 23 years, 2 as business coach with Northwest Missouri State University Small Business Technology and Development Centers, 21 as State Director of the Small Business and Technology Development Centers.

January 1, 2010 the University of Missouri appointed Max "Extension Program Director and Associate Dean - Entrepreneurship & Economic Development", to oversee Extension's Business Development Programs and the MU College of Engineering's outreach programs. Responsibilities include managing entreprenurship, industrial and economic activities. In 2012 he was appointed as a quality consultant and one of four transition leaders to support Extension's Program Integration.

During 1995 and 1996, Max served the national Association of Small Business Development Centers president. In that capacity, he led the membership of more than 950 SBDCs across the country in program and professional development, advocacy and education. Max also served as the national Chairman for the Baldrige based ASBDC Accreditation Committee for five years and served as a member for fourteen years.

He also served eight years as a certified examiner and judge for the Baldrige based Excellence in Missouri Foundation and participated in the annual adjudication process for the Missouri Quality Awards. In 2011 he was appointed by the United States Secretary of Commerce to serve a three year term as a member of the national 11 person Board of Overseers of the Malcolm Baldrige National Quality Award Program.

During his professional career, Max has been active on a number of boards, including those of banks, bank holding companies, insurance companies, hospitals and clinics. In addition, he remains active in civic and church-affiliated organizations.
